COURTESY BUS TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- The Kingsgrove RSL Club Ltd courtesy bus is a free service to our members and their guests with a request a gold coin donation for charity.
- Bookings are to be made through Kingsgrove RSL Club reception on 9336 1500.
- The courtesy bus service will be available every Friday & Saturday Night 4:30pm-12:30am, and Sunday nights from 3:30pm-11pm.
- All pickups will be by appointment only and no standard bookings or pre-booking will be accepted
- Bookings are to be made not prior than 24 hours before pickup or drop off.
- Pick up trips will be every half hour starting at 4.30pm on Friday and Saturdays, and from 3:30pm on Sundays.
- Return trips will be every hour starting from 7pm with final trip at 12:30am on Friday and Saturdays, and final trip at 11pm on Sundays. Members must register with reception for the return trip with a maximum of 11 people in each trip.
- Every attempt will be made to adhere to schedules but the Club reserves the right to introduce a 60-minute time guarantee.
- The courtesy bus is for the use of members and their guests only and holds total capacity of 11 members per trip.
- The courtesy bus will operate within a 5km **driving** radius of the Club only and management have the right to refuse a pickup or drop off based on distance.
- Persons under 18 years must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- In accordance with NSW child restraint laws children under the age of seven (7) years are not permitted on the courtesy bus without approved restraints which are not fitted to this vehicle.
- For safety, all passengers must remain seated whilst the bus is in motion.
- It is illegal to consume alcohol or food on the bus. For the comfort of members and their guests the bus is non-smoking at all times.
- Rules and regulations which apply within Kingsgrove Club premises extend to the confines of the courtesy vehicle.
- For the safety of all members and their guests, the driver has the right to refuse entry to the bus of anyone displaying intoxication or anti-social behaviour including offensive language and objectionable behaviour.
- Days and times of the courtesy bus can be altered at the discretion of management.
- Any breach to the terms and conditions as stated above by a member or their guests could result in disciplinary action.
- Club announcements will be made via the P.A regarding departure times.
