By way of the Bayside City ClubGRANTS Category One and Category Two funding programs, Kingsgrove RSL Club has been able to help build a stronger, healthier, more vibrant and inclusive community.

Through the ClubGRANTS program Kingsgrove RSL Club has enabled schools to provide for student scholarships, purchase of prizes and gifts for raffles, cover venue hire fees for school award nights and presentation days. Kingsgrove RSL Club has also been able to sponsor local community and school sports clubs and groups, with the funding going toward purchasing new apparel, equipment, gear and trophies, as well as ground hire and venue hire fees for games and award presentations.

The funds provided to local and national charities and non for profit organisation have gone to help support community welfare services, health services, manage community centres and establish civic programs to encourage more inclusive societies. One specific example in 2016 was the funding awarded to Bay City Care, which allowed them to establish a new primary school student program to better educate students about bullying and on what is a respectful relationship. In addition to this Bay City Care received another two grants to expand their domestic violence counselling program and improve the domestic violence crises care management service they offer through their Counselling & Support Centre
