

## CLUB NOTICE

Dear Members,

Kingsgrove RSL Club wish to inform you that the Board of Directors have made the decision to temporarily extend the Public Health Order requirement of mandatory proof of COVID-19 vaccination (or medical exemption), as a condition of entry for members and guests beyond 15<sup>th</sup> December 2021.

With the emergence of the new 'Omicron' strain of COVID-19, and the ongoing uncertainty of the impact it may have, along with NSW vaccination rate not yet at 95%, we are taking this proactive step to maintain proof of COVID-19 vaccination until at least 31<sup>st</sup> January 2022.

Although Clubs, beyond 15<sup>th</sup> December will still be required to facilitate QR code check ins, continue with social distancing and continue with good hygiene practices, we do not believe that this is the right time to remove the requirement for proof of COVID-19 Vaccination (or medical exemption).

It is not our intention to unduly inconvenience any of our members, but we are obligated to act in the best interest of the majority. After our engagement with membership and our staff, we believe that this decision is overwhelmingly favoured at this time.

We will continue to monitor the situation to determine when it will be appropriate for us to amend this policy.
